THOMPSON FILES FOR RE-ELECTION TO TEXAS HOUSE

State Representative Ed Thompson today filed as a candidate for re-election to the Texas House of Representatives from Brazoria County. Thompson was elected in 2012 and is now in his first term representing Texas House District 29. The 29th District covers the cities of Pearland, Alvin, Hillcrest, Manvel, Rosharon, Iowa Colony, Brookside Village and Liverpool in Northeast Brazoria County.

In Thompson's first year, he was named as one of the most conservative leaders in the Texas House and has received several awards for his voting record.

In his first term, Thompson's priority was keeping taxes low, getting funds returned to Texas education, and solving the long-term water and transportation needs.
