## ELISA CHAN FILES FOR STATE SENATE

Former San Antonio Councilwoman Elisa Chan today filed papers with the Texas Republican Party to be placed on the primary ballot for Texas State Senate District 25 which covers North-Central Bexar, Kendall, Comal and parts of Hays, Guadalupe and Travis Counties.

Until her resignation from the Council to seek this Senate seat, Chan represented San Antonio's conservative Council District 9. She is President of Unitech Consulting Engineers, a structural and civil engineering firm founded by Chan and her husband, Clifford, 21 years ago. Chan is a dedicated fiscal and social conservative who has enjoyed the strong support of voters in her three elections.
