



REPRESENTATIVE JOHNSON FILES FOR 2014 DEMOCRATIC PRIMARY

Dallas, TX – Today State Representative Eric Johnson (D-Dallas) filed the necessary paperwork to place his name on the ballot for the 2014 Democratic Primary. He is seeking re-election to the Texas House of Representatives.

"I am once again seeking the nomination of my party to represent the hard working people of District 100 in the Texas House," said Representative Johnson. *"I look forward to returning to Austin to continue the fight for better schools, safer communities, and an economy that works for all the people of our state."*

Representative Johnson first won the Democratic nomination for State Representative for District 100 in a contested primary in 2010. He was subsequently re-nominated in 2012. He has represented District 100 in the Texas House of Representatives since 2010.

Eric Johnson represents District 100, which includes parts of Dallas and Mesquite, in the Texas House of Representatives. He currently serves as the Vice Chairman of the House Committee on Natural Resources and the Vice Chairman of the House Committee on General Investigating and Ethics.
