Rep. Mary E. González files for re-election Gonzalez has raised over \$50.000 since June

El Paso, TX-- Rep. Mary E. González (D-El Paso) filed for re-election today at the El Paso Democratic Party Headquarters. González also announced that she has raised over \$50,000 since the legislative fundraising moratorium ended in June.
