Representative Nevárez Announces Re-Election for District 74

Austin, TX – As this historic 83rd legislative session continues with the calling of a 3rd special session, campaign announcements are starting to commence. At his first campaign fundraiser in his hometown of Eagle Pass, Democratic Caucus' 'Freshman of the Year' Representative Poncho Nevárez proudly announced he will run for re-election in 2014.

“I am honored to have served district 74 in my first legislative session,” states Nevárez. **“If there's a better job around than serving HD 74, I'd like to see it.”**

Nevárez greatly contributed to the 83rd legislative session by helping restore \$3.9 billion to public education and reducing the number of 'End of Course' testing to stop children from being over tested, as well as voting to fund water strategies to tackle the drought that his district and the rest of the state are facing. He also added key language to SB 215 by returning power to public institutions of higher education when it comes to the decision of consolidating or eliminating low producing certificate or degree programs. Furthermore, he also passed a bill that will ensure the protection of the elderly or disabled who are being exploited, neglected, or abused allowing professional councilors to make psychological assessments.
