fter the terror attacks of 9/11, Sam Brown made a very personal decision that would forever change the course of his life - he decided to follow in his father's footsteps and join the United States military. He was accepted to the United States Military Academy at West Point, following the lead of some of America's greatest leaders.

After graduation, Sam was rewarded with a great responsibility – directing a platoon of soldiers amid heavy combat in the Kandahar Desert of Afghanistan, one of the most dangerous regions in the world.

In September of 2008, while providing backup to an ambushed patrol, Sam's vehicle drove over an improvised explosive device that left him fighting for his life.

With more than thirty surgeries at Brooke Army Medical Center in San Antonio, Sam's recovery was long and intensive. Unable to continue his service on the battlefield, Sam re-focused his service-minded spirit toward new opportunities of service, and moved to Dallas to help launch a new non-profit supporting returning veterans.




