Dear Governor Abbott:

In light of the dramatic spike in COVID-19 cases and increased ICU hospitalizations, face coverings are needed to protect Texans from exposure in public settings, protect Texas jobs, and keep Texas open for business.

The daily count of new COVID-19 cases passed the 6,000 mark for the first time on Tuesday, June 30th and quickly escalated to over 8,000 cases on Wednesday, July 1st, with 8,076 new cases reported.

With the Fourth of July celebrations upon us, your actions will undoubtedly protect Texans, help contain the spread of the virus, and ensure the sustainability of our state's economy. We thank you for your leadership throughout this pandemic and want to express our gratitude for the tireless efforts of our health professionals, emergency responders, and volunteers who remain on the front lines in this fight!
